**If you are a former CCT employee who was laid off recently, you may be eligible for a wide variety of job re-entry and career counseling services.**

NH Works is a team of state agencies and partners committed to providing you with assistance necessary to return to work and to pursue a career. NH Works will soon be mailing you valuable information about services available to you. Until then, here's what you can do immediately:

**1. File for unemployment benefits from NH Employment Security at your local NH Works Career Center.**

**2. Ask about your eligibility for food stamp benefits and other programs at your local Division of Health & Human Services office.**
