# ApprenticeshipUSA 101

- Earn while you learn model
- Consists of five elements
  - Employment
  - Structured on-the-job learning
  - Related education
  - Progressive wages
  - National industry certificate

# ApprenticeshipUSA 101

- Apprenticeship programs range in length from one to five years.
- Many programs include the opportunity to earn college credit that may be applied to the future pursuit of a college degree while accumulating little to no student loan debt.

# Registered Apprenticeship in New Hampshire

- Currently 285 Registered Apprenticeship (RA) programs with more than 2,000 apprentices in New Hampshire

FY-16

- Added 12 quality Apprenticeship Programs
- Registered nearly 500 apprentices
- 187 completed their apprenticeship
