Questions and Answers

1. What are the current regions and programs funded by the In-School Youth dollars, and who are the current subcontractors?
In that there is insufficient funding to realistically fund several regions, this RFP is **not** broken into regions. Currently funded with WIOA Title I In-School Youth funds is My-Turn Inc. at Nashua South/North High School and NH-JAG at Manchester Memorial High School.
2. What current schools partner and send students to the In-School Youth programs?
Manchester Memorial High School and Nashua South/North High Schools.
3. What are the funding levels available for the In-School Youth regions?
There are no In-School Youth regions; there is \$408,000 available for In-School Youth programming statewide. It is hoped that we can stretch the dollars as far as possible recognizing the limited availability and program requirements.
4. Are there any current or anticipated service or geographic gaps for the In-School Youth funding and programs?
There are significant service and geographic gaps for In-School youth programming when there was, in the past, only funding available for two programs. NH is a minimum funded WIOA Title I state due to low unemployment, low welfare, and other low social indicators. The statute requires that a minimum of 75% of our projected statewide youth funds be expended on out-of-school youth (drop out recovery or occupational skill development).
5. Can the funding be leveraged or braided with other state and/or federal funding to complete a program budget?
Definitely and this is certainly encouraged to leverage or braid with other state and federal funding to complete a program budget.
